All skaters, regardless of home club or membership status, must follow and uphold the provisions in this Skater Code of Conduct. All club members are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship and be courteous toward their fellow skater, coaches, parents/guardians of skaters, and U.S Figure Skating officials and guests.

- 1. All skaters must sign in at the front desk before getting on the ice.
- 2. While in lesson or skating on freestyle ice, it is the skater's responsibility to always be conscientious and aware of other skaters around them.
- 3. Skaters skating their program to music has the right of way on freestyle
- 4. Advanced skaters are expected to exhibit patience towards beginner skaters.
- 5. Unsafe or discourteous behavior will not be tolerated.
- 6. Conflicts will be resolved calmly and peacefully without resorting to hostility.
